Students will participate in courses that consist of classroom and hands on experience to become certified Daycare Providers.

### **99 Hour Certification Program**

This three course program meets  
Requirements for director and senior  
Staff positions at daycare facilities in  
Maryland (COMAR 07.04.02)

#### **Child Care I: Growth and Development**

This course satisfies 45 hours of the 99 hour requirements, and is an introduction to the early childhood educations.

#### **Child Care II: Activities for Young Children**

This course satisfies 45 hours of the 99 hour requirements, and is an introduction to activities for children birth- six years of age.

\*\*\* Prerequisite Successful completion of Childcare I

#### **Communication Skills for Childcare Professionals**

This course satisfies 9 hours of the 99 hour requirements, students will learn speaking, writing, and interpersonal communication strategies.

### **Childcare Courses:**

#### **Group Care of Infants and Toddlers**

This course is designed to introduce students to the social and cognitive growth of young children. Meets MSDE requirements for senior staff in Infant Care (45 Hours)

#### **The School Age Child**

This course is designed to introduce students to the basic concepts of development of the child six years to twelve years of age.  
Meets MSDE requirements for certification of school age child group leaders (45 Hours).

**Family Provider Start-up Classes**

The following courses meet the new MSDE requirement for persons interested in becoming licensed family child care providers you must take all six 4 hour modules.

- Module 1: Child Development
- Module 2: Curriculum
- Module 3: Health, Safety, Nutrition
- Module 4: Special Needs
- Module 5: Professionalism
- Module 6: Community
