



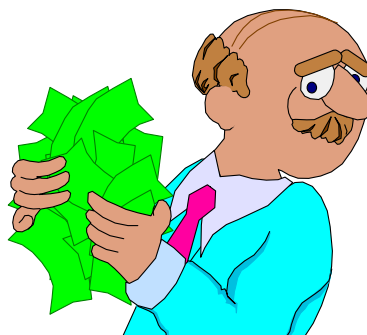
NOTICE TO STUDENTS WITHDRAWING FROM ALL CLASSES

Students receiving federal financial aid who withdraw from all classes or stop attending **may be responsible to repay** a portion of federal grants received to the U.S. Department of Education and to The Community College of Baltimore County (CCBC).

CCBC will calculate the amount of federal aid that you have “earned” based on the number of days you were enrolled or attended and the number of days in the semester. This percentage is used to obtain the amount of aid you actually earned. Based on the total amount of aid you received, a portion of the “unearned” aid must be returned by CCBC to the U.S. Department of Education.

Any unpaid tuition, fees, and book charges on your account that is created by the return of funds will be billed to you. You will not be allowed to enroll in future classes until your bill is paid in full.

Always talk to an advisor before you withdraw from classes. Remember, the Office of Learning Support Services provides tutoring and other services to help you be successful in your courses.
